Local Programs we support:

Arrowhead Youth & Family Services

Their mission is to motivate youth-at-risk to become productive and responsible young people by providing the highest quality counseling, education, and social services to youth and their families. Social Concerns also provides birthday celebration treats to the residents.

Catholic Care Packs

For the past year, our CTK family has been working with local law enforcement agencies to provide help for people experiencing homelessness and those recently released from jail. Catholic Care Packs was the brainchild of Rock Island County Sheriff's Deputy Tim Ott. While working security at the RI County Courthouse, Ott became aware of the needs of homeless people when they left the jail.

Christian Care

By providing safe shelter, support and resources, Christian Care empowers both the homeless and vets in need of assistance to make positive changes in every aspect of their lives. They operate a community meal site that serves well over 50,000 meals a year and a 24/7 Crisis Line.

Family Resources

Engages and serves children and families in need with dignity, compassion, and respect by building upon individual community strengths to resolve life challenges together.

Habitat for Humanity's Home Repair Program

Offers home repair services to home- owners so they can continue to live in safe, decent homes. Repair work includes painting, land- scaping, weatherization and minor repair services to preserve home exteriors and revitalize neighborhoods.

Haven of Hope (formerly St. Joseph Worker House)

A welcoming family home in Rock Island where homeless women and children live without cost. QC Haven of Hope is nondenominational and nonprofit.

Humility Homes and Services

Over the past several years Humility Homes and Services has assisted hundreds of individuals and families who experienced homelessness find safe, quality housing and assisted them in re-establishing their own loving homes. The organization has led the effort in the Quad Cities to end homelessness and expand housing options and related supportive services for low-income families.

King's Harvest Ministries

Serves the poor and homeless in the Quad Cities by meeting their physical, emotional & spiritual needs and by showing them who Jesus is through compassion and unconditional love.

Hope At The Brick House

Quad Cities is an organization which serves at-risk children. Hope at the Brick House has an after school program, a summer program and also provides stability, support and safety for at-risk children and families who are in unstable situations.

Project Now

A Community Action Agency serving Rock Island, Henry, and Mercer counties in Illinois helping families with low incomes and seniors. A few of the services provided are: help with housing, budgeting, clothing, energy assistance, Head Start, rent and security deposit assistance. Each year Social Concerns donates window fans to this agency for people in need, as well as supporting their Utility Assistance program.

River Bend Food Bank

The food bank was started in the 60's and now serves over 200 area agencies, having a variety of programs available in the Quad Cities, including the school pantry program, the back-pack program and the mobile food pantry.

YouthHope

A ministry of Christian Friendliness, ministers to more than 500 low-income kids & teens weekly through after-school activities, a Christian youth camp, and other youth services. Each year Social Concerns donates funds to send low income kids to Camp Summit.
