## **How You Can Help**

- **Join our Committee!** We invite anyone interested to come to a Social Concerns meeting at 1:00 PM on the 2nd Tuesday of the month in the Believer's Together Center and see how you might be able to help us help others.
- Cook for or Serve Food at the monthly meal site (Sign up at church when we have sign-up drive.) We serve in one site in Rock Island on the first Wednesday of the month. The menu is always the same: Tator tot casserole (recipe provided), baked beans, applesauce, buttered bread, milk and dessert. You can choose to purchase and prepare the food- which you drop off at Christ the King parking lot; and/or you can help to serve the meal at the site.
- Eat at our Restaurant Fundraisers. Use the coupon from the bulletin for specified dates/times at local restaurants; a percentage of your purchase will be given to the Social Concerns Committee.
- Shop for supplies for specific Social Concerns projects: Sign up at church for school supplies, Christmas gifts, food baskets, or give monetary donations for those collections.
- Help with our spring "Garden of Eden" rummage sale. We need lots of people to help set up, tear down, and work during the sales. Donate your gently used items to these sales. The rummage sale accepts everything except clothing, computers, computer equipment, and Christmas trees.
- **Donate to "basket collections"** held periodically after Mass the 2nd Sunday of the month.
